

Sitting Pretty Pink Cake By Nanci Jarvis

ere's a pretty pink cake for a June bridal shower! Many of the materials are free or easy to find.

What You'll Need:

- · CD (source: junk mail)
- Paper doily
- · Large plastic cap (approx. 2" diameter x 3/8" h. from vitamin bottle)
- Smaller cap (mine had a "toothed" top)
- Clear pony beads
- · White Tacky Glue
- Acrylic paint: White, Pink
- Roses and pearls (fabric shop, child's necklace)
- Green plastic leaves
- Baby's breath
- · Pink seed beads
- Cardstock
- · Clear nail polish
- **1.** Cut a pattern from within the doily and glue to the CD.
- 2. Paint caps white (as a primer). Let dry. Paint both pink. Let dry.
- 3. Glue larger cap to top of doily, centered.
- **4.** Cut a piece of doily to cover top of larger cap. Glue to cap.
- **5.** Stack and glue three sets of three clear pony beads. Let dry.
- **6.** Cut a circle from cardstock to cover the smaller cap's open side. Glue in place.
- **7.** Glue each pony bead "leg" to cardstock on bottom of smaller cap.
- **8.** Cut scalloped shapes from doily to fit sides of smaller cap. Glue in place.





9. On each scallop, glue seed beads as shown.

Doily scallop 1 seed bead 2 seed beads ·3 seed beads

- 10. On top of smaller cap, glue another piece of doily.
- **11.** Glue seed beads all the way around top of smaller cap, leaving slight gaps between beads. If you don't have a "toothed" cap, stack and glue a row of seed beads around edge, leaving slight space between each bead. When dry, glue a single bead between and on top of each base bead.



- **12.** Paint fabric roses the same color pink as the cake. It may require two coats. When dry, apply clear nail polish.
- **13.** At very top of cake, glue on one rose, three plastic leaves and tiny bit of baby's breath.
- **14.** Glue smaller cap (with legs) to larger cap.

- **15.** In middle of larger cap, glue one rose and some leaves, with rounded leaf ends pointing out. Add some sprigs of baby's breath. Glue seed beads to outer edge.
- **16**. At bottom edge of cap, glue three roses together, side by side. Let the shape of the doily dictate where to place the roses. I used four sets of three roses.
- **17.** Glue leaves on each side of roses, and one leaf stalk pointing out from middle rose.
- **18.** Cut sections of pearls from necklace. Glue beneath each center rose. Glue sprig of baby's breath on top of pearls.
